Description

Hello, my name is Cameron Livingston. I have been in 4-H for almost two years now, having started 4-H in February of 2019, and I would like to take some of your time to discuss more about myself and my lambs. I have two wether lambs in the market sheep project, whose names are Ghost and Speckles.

To take care of our sheep, my little brother and I wake up at 6:30 am every morning to work together to give them their food and then, after a brief rest, exercise them to develop their muscles. We also hand-walk and brace them for at least 20 minutes per sheep each day so that we can excel in the showmanship class of the project. So that they can properly digest their food, after 12 hours have passed from the morning, we give the sheep their nightly feeding at around 7 pm. Each lamb is tethered by it's feed bin at their feeding time so that we are able to monitor how they are eating. Perhaps the most time consuming part of their care is washing and clipping them, however it is something that has helped to teach us that consistent, routine care is very beneficial in the long run.

Although it has changed how the show will be done, we are also glad that the Fair has set up a way for people to still support 4-H kids in our projects, even if we are not able to meet directly. I would love for you to see my sheep's listings as I am proud of how well both my lamb and I have progressed through this crazy year and I wish you a healthy and happy rest of your year.
