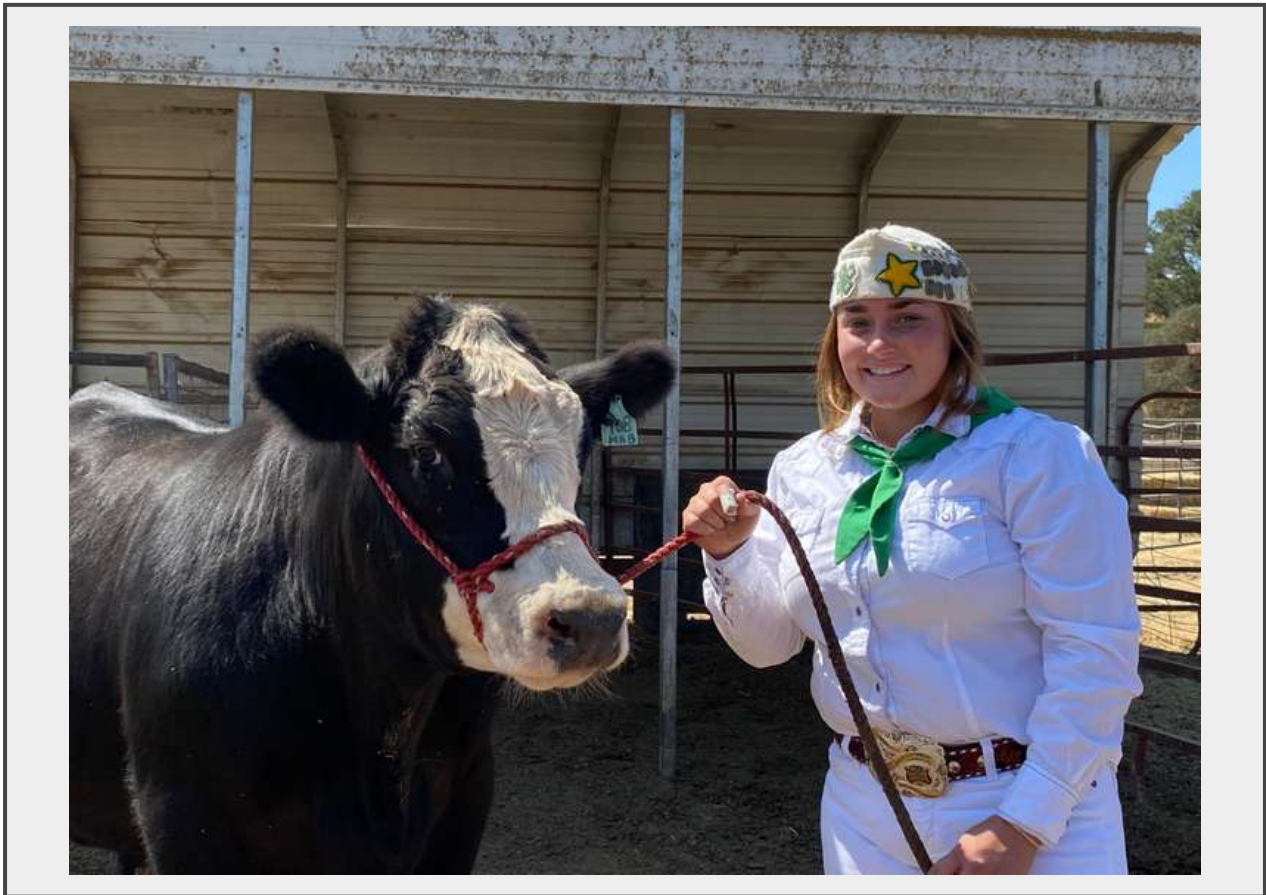

### **Description**

This year I was lucky enough to get drawn to go to High School Rodeo Nationals in Guthrie, Oklahoma. I went in reined cow horse, cutting and goat tying. I have won three saddles and many buckles over the years.

This year I am taking a steer to Lake County Junior Livestock Auction. I have had my steer, Otis, since November. He is an Angus cross. Otis came from the Suenram Ranch in Kelseyville where I have gotten multiple steers in the past. Right now, he weighs roughly 1350 LB and should weigh in around 1400Lb. He has been fed grass hay as his roughage and Artois steer mix. Artois steer feed is a mix of corn, cottonseed, and soy pellets.
