They were market rabbit, breeding rabbit, show rabbit, turkey, ducks, market chickens, show chickens, pocket pets (where I showed my tarantula), self determined (where I showed my pet pig), llama/alpaca, cavy(guinea pig), leathercraft, quilting, clothing construction and shooting sports. I set a goal of winning a belt buckle this year and I achieved that goal. I have learned a lot this year. I will take the things I learned to make my projects better next year. One of the things I learned was to be better prepared and not to wait until the last minute to finish my projects.

I am feeding my chickens a meat bird feed by Nature Wise which has 22% protein. As a treat, and to add more protein, I scramble up extra chicken eggs and feed it to them.

Raising the chickens are a lot different then feeding my show chickens. The chicken feed needs to be measured out and they need to be fed twice a day, so they do not grow to fast. I also add Broiler Booster which contains Vitamin A, D, E, B-12, electrolytes, and biotin, to their water to help counteract weak legs due to their quick growth.

It was so fun raising the chickens as they got older they were like attacking dinosaurs every time it was feeding time.
