Being my first year showing a market goat, I've learned a lot from this experience as I have never raised any sort of livestock and my family doesn't come from an agriculture background. I'd like to introduce you to Tucker, my 90lb market wether. Tucker is a Boer cross, who I hand-selected with honestly very little knowledge almost in a way some could consider as taking a leap of faith. I came into raising Tucker with little knowledge, but I learned quickly how to raise him, and also learned that this wasn't going to be an inexpensive project. I am proud to say that I have fully funded this

project myself while working part-time at a local pizza restaurant, and doing any odd jobs family members offered to make a few extra dollars.

For those who don't know me, I am also a three-sport varsity athlete and learned that time management was going to be my biggest challenge as I live a busy life. Through all of this, I made time to feed him grain twice a day, refill his water, clean his pen regularly, take him on daily walks, and practice showmanship with my advisors at least once a week. Tucker has been on a strict alfalfa and grain diet with his grain source being a healthy mix of Lamb Slam and Dominator Goat, manufactured by Associated Feeds of Turlock, California. Tucker also has not been fed any supplements.
