I feed my steers high noon feed I get it out of Burlington. They are getting 12 pounds morning and night with clean water and hay.

I am very happy that I have done well the last 2 years, but my main goal is not to win it is having a good quality steer and nice marbling on the meat so whoever buys my animals at the end of the year is very happy with the meat quality and work I have put into my steers.
